Everything we do at the Reno Wind Symphony is to improve the quality of life in our Northern Nevada community. We do that by producing professional and entertaining performances for our audiences, providing high-quality and challenging musical experiences for our musicians, and promoting artistic enrichment in our arts community.

Over the last ten years, the Reno Wind Symphony has become a staple family-oriented, classical music tradition for citizens of Northern Nevada. We have done that by striving to continue the history of concert bands and the legacies of Sousa and Fillmore, as well as enhancing and promoting the modern wind ensemble of the 21st century.

The Reno Wind Symphony performs four to seven concerts a year at Nightingale Concert Hall on the campus of the University of Nevada. Concerts are a mixture of contemporary, classical, and popular works for wind ensemble or symphonic band.

In January 2006, the Reno Wind Symphony was founded by Dr. A. G. “Mack” McGrannahan III, Director of Bands Emeritus/Professor of Music Emeritus at the University of Nevada, who serves as Conductor and Artistic Advisor. The group is comprised of 65 musicians from our community, many with day jobs, who come together to rehearse each week with the same belief that drives them. The belief that music and the arts improve the quality of their life and the lives of our community members.
